Position: Volunteer Fire Fighter

Reports To: Fire Chief

General Statement: Under the direct supervision of the Fire Chief, a fire fighter works with the Lindstrom Fire Department to put out grass, vehicle and structure fires. They also respond to other emergency and non-emergency calls for service, in a timely manner.

Responsibilities:

- A. When alerted to an emergency situation, immediately report to the Lindstrom Fire Station for response to call.**
- B. In the case of a fire or other emergency situation, assist other fire fighters or emergency personnel in mobilizing the appropriated equipment to address the specific situation.**
- C. Attends all training sessions and meetings unless specifically excused by the Fire Chief or other Admin Officer. (1 drill and 1 meeting per month)**
- D. Keep the Lindstrom Fire Station and all related equipment in a clean and orderly condition.**
- E. Assist's Law Enforcement, EMS and other fire departments under mutual aid agreements.**
- F. Demonstrates, by personal example, the highest standards of conduct and work ethic, both on and off the job.**

Qualifications:

- A. Physically Fit**
- B. High School Diploma or equivalent too.**
- C. Currently possess or able to pass the Fire Fighter I and II training within one year of being accepted as a Fire Fighter Trainee.**
- D. Currently have a valid class "C" MN stated driver's license (or better)**
- E. Ability to lift 50 pounds.**
- F. Required to reside within five (5) driving miles of the Lindstrom Fire Station, except for persons who have full time day employment in the City of Lindstrom.**
- G. Ability to deal with the public in an informed, pleasant and professional manner.**
